

ITINERARY



June 21 (Day 1)

Arrive in Lamu

Fly to Lamu and check-in at hotel. You will take a tour through Shela village to discover the local sites and shops. The day will end with a traditional dhow sunset ruse through the mangroove



June 22 (Day 2)

A day in Lamu exploring sights and sounds of the UNESCO World Heritage Site

The day activities will include a visit to the Lamu UNESCO World Heritage Town, where you will have a town tour and visit several monuments including the Lamu Fort, the National Museum, Swahili House and German Post Office, to explore the 700 year history of the Town. The day will also include a tour through Takwa ruins on Manda Island.



June 23 (Day 3)

Exploring Pate and Manda Islands

You will take a day trip to Pate Island for a cultural immersion tour, as well as visit renowned historical sites such as Siyu Fort, Pate old town, and Shanga. You will end the day with a sundowners at Manda Bay appreciating the view and the privacy and exclusivity of the pristine beaches of Manda Toto Islands



June 24 (Day 4)

Depart from Lamu to Nairobi

Flights from Lamu start at 10am so you can spend a leisurely morning strolling on the beach awaiting your departure.
