— Hadith (Muslim)



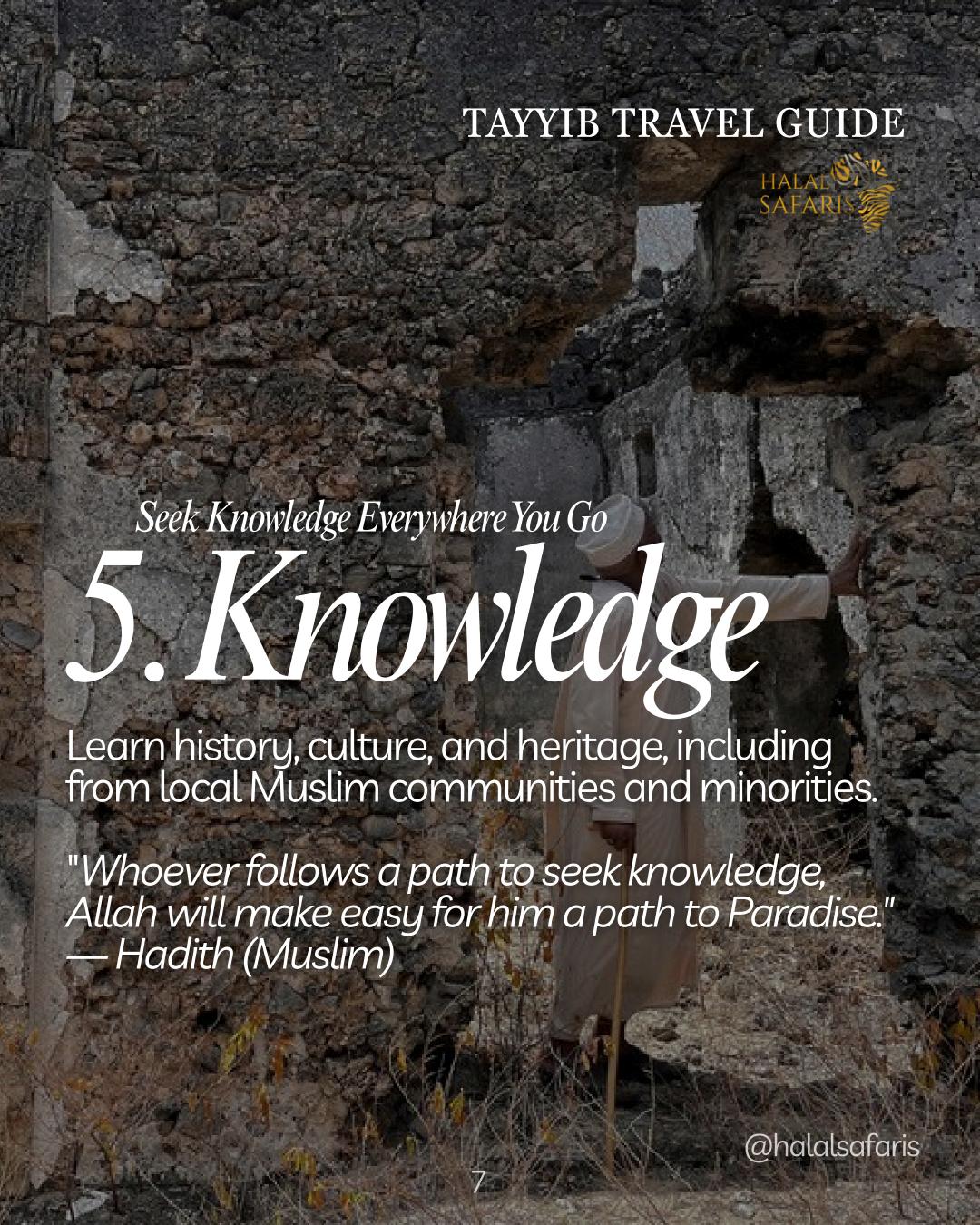

## 4. Chity

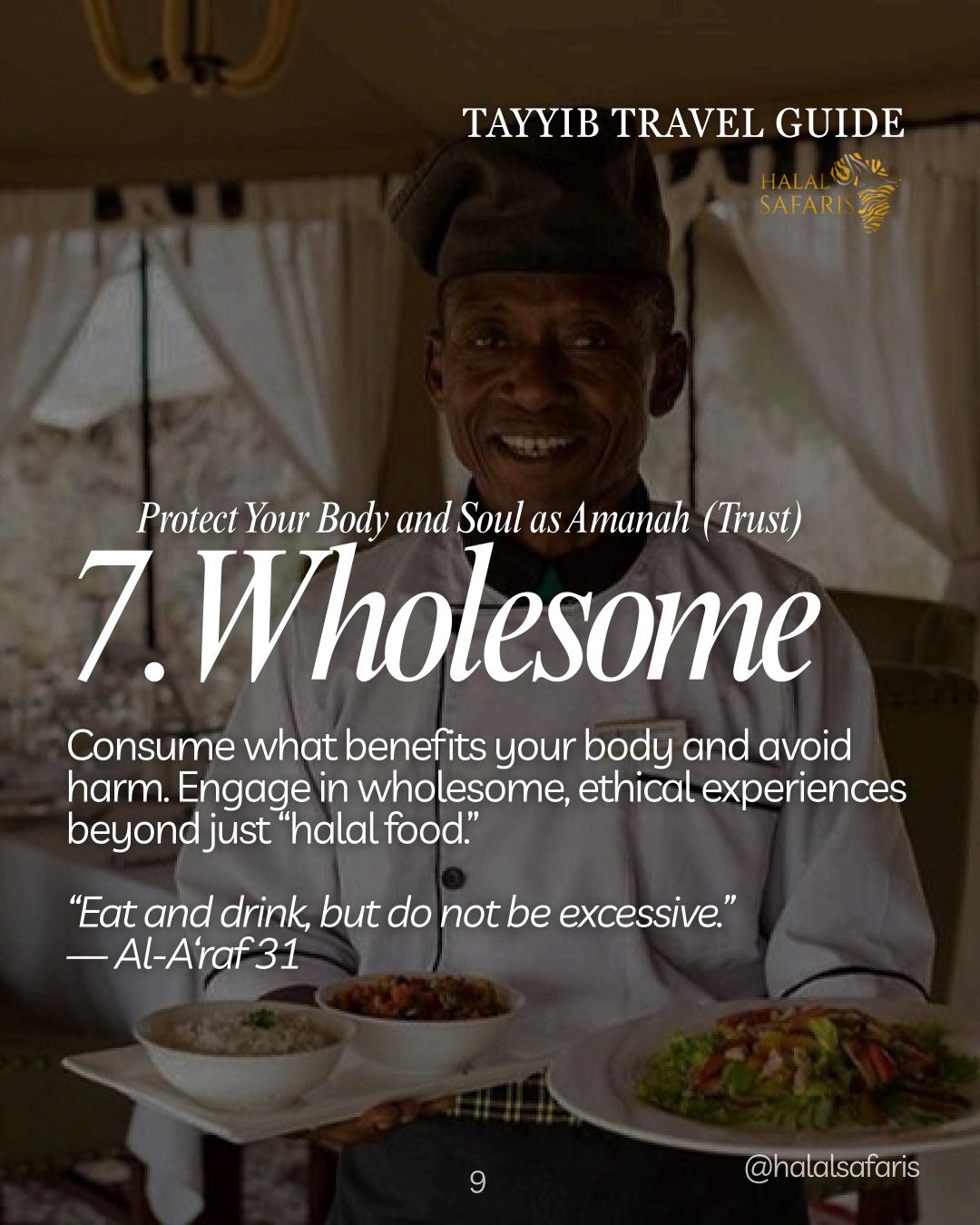
Volunteer, donate, or participate ethically, ensuring empowerment and respect.
